We are very excited to invite you to Glendore Public School's Easter Hat Parade and Family Picnic. All students K-6 are involved in the parade which is being held on Thursday, 28th March 2024 at 10:00am. CANTEEN:

All donations are to be placed in the Easter Craft Donations Tub at the School Admin Office by Monday 18th March 2024. Students who do not celebrate Easter will be able to make a non-Easter hat in a theme of their choosing.
