The following story is based on a traditional Aboriginal Dreaming story of how the koala came to have a short, stumpy tail.

Long, long ago in the Dreaming, there lived Koala and Tree Kangaroo. They were the very best of friends. Back then, Koala had a very long, furry tail just like his friend, Tree Kangaroo.

One year, there was no rain. All of the streams, rivers and lakes were dried up and no water was found anywhere. Even the leaves in the trees were dying. Koala said, "What are we going to do? We are going to die if we don't get some water to drink." Just then, Tree Kangaroo

had a plan. He remembered back to the last dry season when his mother dug a hole in a dry stream bed. "She dug for hours until water began to fill the bottom of the dry hole," said Tree Kangaroo. "Let's try that!" said Koala.


