

Glendore P&C Colour Run Fundraiser



Dear Parents/Caregivers,

Our school's Colour Run will be held on **Friday**, **16th November from 1:45pm**. The cost is **\$5.00**, which includes participation in the event. You may wish to pack a frozen drink to enjoy at the conclusion of the event. <u>Payment is to be made in cash placed in the P&C Money Box in the foyer</u>.

As this is a school fundraiser, your support of the event is appreciated.

Frequently asked Questions

What is the Colour Run/ What should I wear?

The Colour Run is a course where students can walk, jog, or run through colour checkpoints. Teachers and support staff will gently throw coloured powder on students' white T-shirts, which will best show the colour. This is a fun way to raise money in support of our school.

How is the colour administered? Will my student be hurt or harmed?

No, it does not hurt at all. The colour is a powder made out of **maize starch (corn flour)** and colour. The powder is food-grade quality, nontoxic and completely biodegradable. Teachers will do their best to throw the powder at students' torsos. However, wind and other factors can cause the powder blow onto faces. Water Pistols and spray bottles will be used to wet students before they enter the colour zone. The colour zone can be bypassed completely if a student does not wish to go through it or if they have a corn allergy.

How do I protect my eyes and/or airways during the run?

As with any dust-like substances, Colour Runs aim to keep the product out of eyes. Our teachers will aim low as students pass by. Students can bring goggles or sunglasses to protect their eyes, if they would like. The amount of colour will be appropriate for the experience. It will not overwhelm or be scary for the students. Participants can bring bandanas or dust masks from home to protect their airways.

Will the colour ruin clothes or running shoes?

The colour does mostly wash out after the event. As with anything dirty, the sooner you wash it the better. We suggest wearing items that you wouldn't mind getting colourful. If you would like to preserve the colour in your running shirt, spray it with vinegar and iron it on.

Can spectators and other children attend the Colour Run?

Spectators are welcome to attend, however only Glendore Public School students are allowed to participate in the run. Spectators are asked to sign in upon arrival in front of the office and make their way to either the K-2 eating area, seating in front of the basketball court or yarning circle to watch the action.

Will the colour affect the inside of cars?

Please bring a towel for the insides of cars, just in case.
